### COVID Update

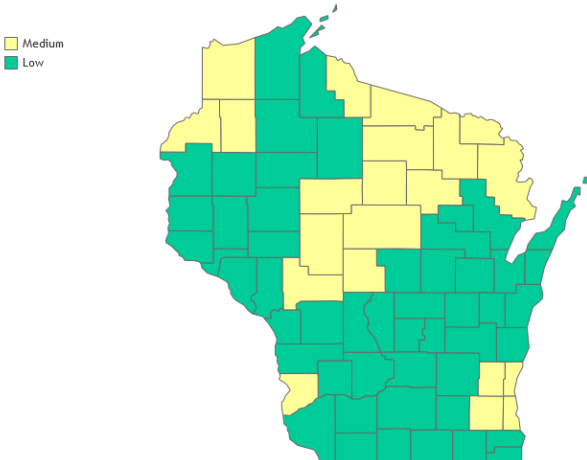
Well, here we go again! We have a single positive test in the Westview Assisted Living complex and a single positive test in the Retirement apartments. Therefore, Westview is in outbreak mode again.

Westview staff will be required to wear N95 masks and face shields when in the unit. Visitors are required to wear a hospital grade mask and we are strongly encouraging them to wear face shields as well.

In all other areas of the facility staff will be wearing the normal hospital mask. Visitors for HC and RCAC will be asked to wear a hospital mask. Staff are testing in Westview on Mondays and Thursdays. Residents are being tested on those days as well.

### COVID Community Level Data

On Friday December 2, 2022 the State Community Levels map showed some significant change compared to the map from two weeks ago, especially in the Northeastern counties. As of last Friday no counties were showing High levels of activity. That remains unchanged from two weeks ago. However, 21 counties are now showing Medium levels, up from 13 two weeks ago. 51 counties are now showing Low levels of COVID, down from 59 two weeks ago. Let's hope this trend doesn't continue in the weeks to come.
