COVID Update

As we move into the new year, things seem to have quieted down a little bit. We have had one new positive test in Westview which keeps them in “Outbreak Mode”. The new date where they could potentially come out of Outbreak Mode would be January 26th.

The Health Center is still in Outbreak Mode. Because there have been no additional positive tests since our last report, they are scheduled to come out of Outbreak this Thursday, January 19th.

There are no active cases in the apartments at this time so there are no restrictions implemented in this area of the campus.

All staff will continue to test on Mondays and Thursdays or at the start of their first shift after Monday or Thursday. Activities will remain in isolated groups such as Health Center 1st floor, Health Center 2nd floor, Westview, and the Apartments. There will be no combined activities at this time. Residents will be in a testing protocol as well.

N95 masks and face shields will be required for staff while in any resident area of the building. Hospital masks and face shields are required for visitors seeing loved ones anywhere in the building.

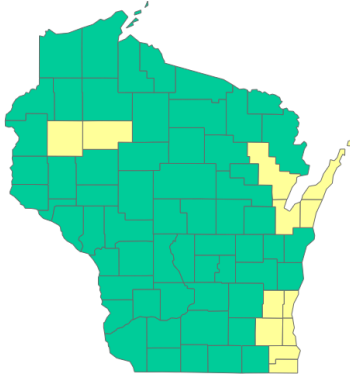

COVID Community Level Data

The DHS State Community Levels map for Friday, January 13, 2023 showed some encouraging signs across the state. As of Friday the 13th, no counties were showing High levels of activity. That has remained unchanged for a number of weeks now. The good news is that only 12 counties are now showing Medium levels, down from 28 just two weeks ago. Plus, 60 counties are now showing Low levels of COVID, up from 44 two weeks ago. Even better, Richland county is back in the low category. This is a good way to start the new year and let's just pray it continues on.
