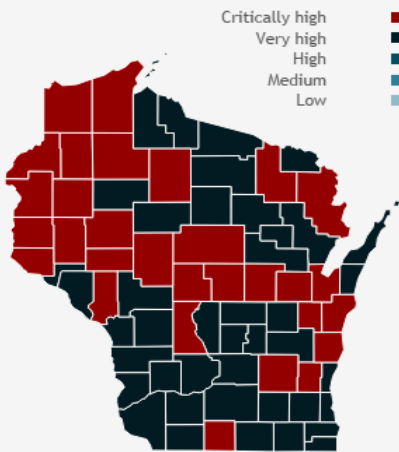

According to the COVID-19 update site we have been following, Richland County has now had 2,329 cases of COVID-19. Of these cases, 159 remain active and there have been 26 deaths attributed to COVID in the county.



A look at Wisconsin's 9 counties shows another huge step backward. 30 counties are now classified as "Critically High", an increase of 15 from last week. Of the remaining 42 counties, all are classified as "Very High" and no counties are classified as "Medium". These changes are pretty scary. Remember, vaccinate, wear a mask and practice social distancing.
