#### **Test Results Update**

**Westview:** We have some wonderful news to report in this edition of the Family Ties. We have now officially completed our two weeks of all negative test results within Westview. That means it has been two weeks or more since any of the Westview residents have tested positive and it has been at least two weeks since any of the Westview staff have tested positive.

Therefore we are officially out of Outbreak Mode in Westview. No one is in quarantine and the special restrictions, such as meals being served in rooms, are all lifted. Any guidelines which were in place prior to going into Outbreak Mode will still be in place, but all the special restrictions are now lifted.

This is a happy day for the residents and staff in Westview! Congratulations to the Westview staff for their tremendous response to this critical situation. Their actions prevented any further spread of the virus.

**Health Center:** We are also happy to report that all the Health Center residents were tested today. All of these tests came back as negative again. We are still waiting on a few staff test results from November 27th.

**Richland County Update**

Richland County health officials announced that the latest data shows there have been a total of 865 positive COVID-19 cases in Richland County. 372 of those cases are still considered active and there have been 13 deaths related to complications from the virus. The additional death was confirmed in the County’s November 27th press release.
