“Outbreak Mode”

Due to new positive test results within our campus we are operating under an “Outbreak Mode” until further notice. This designation affects both Health Center 1 & 2. We have one resident and a number of staff members who have tested positive for the virus. We will remain in “Outbreak Mode” for at least two weeks. You will be updated as this situation changes.

Westview is in “Outbreak Mode” because one staff person has tested positive as well. They too will remain in this mode for at least two weeks.


Current CDC Guidelines must be followed while we are in “Outbreak Mode” in order to continue to operate within State and Federal Guidelines. These guidelines are as follows:

- 1.) Staff must wear an N95 mask and a face shield whenever they enter an affected area.
- 2.) All residents in the affected areas will be tested every 3-7 days.
- 3.) All fully vaccinated staff will be tested every Monday and Thursday until the outbreak mode is lifted.
- 4.) All staff that are not fully vaccinated will be tested prior to the beginning of each shift.
- 5.) Special procedures for serving resident meals will be put in place.
- 6.) There will be no additional restrictions on visitations. However, as always, visitors must wear masks in all areas of the building.

COVID Community Levels Data

Today, Friday September 9th, the State map showed some pretty positive news. Only 3 counties were showing High levels of activity, while 25 counties were showing Medium levels and 44 counties were showing low levels of COVID activity. Richland County remains categorized as a county with low activity and this is good.
